Neuroscience & Early Childhood Handwriting

*In [pre-literate 5-year olds] who had practiced **self-generated printing by hand**, the **neural activity** was far more enhanced and "adult-like" than in those who had simply looked at letters.*

*The brain's "reading circuit" of linked regions that are activated during **reading** was activated during **hand writing**, but not during typing.*

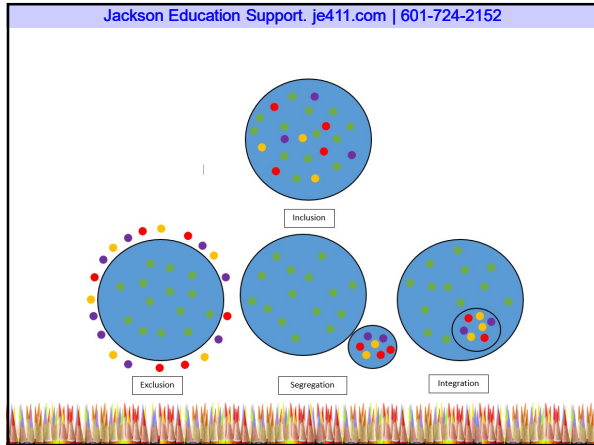
*Writing letters in **meaningful context**, as opposed to just writing them as drawing objects, produced much more robust activation of many areas in both hemispheres.*

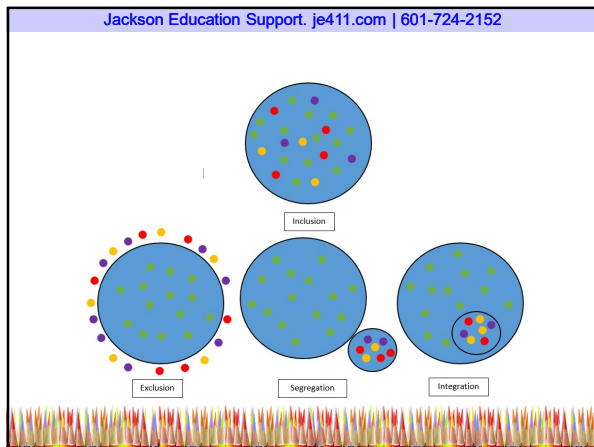
